How it Works


A call to Paint

In July 2021, the City of Harrisburg will place an "all call" for local artists to submit their proposals and potential designs to the City for review and discussion. Upon approving a design and the artists, the City of Harrisburg will then contract with both the Building Owner to lease their wall space, and employ the artist to begin work.

In securing an agreement with the building owner, the City is able to enforce rights and ownership of the mural itself and protect from potential destruction by the Property Owner.

To cover the costs of the artist's time, it is expected that each mural will pay a stipend of \$1,000.00.

Additionally, the City of Harrisburg and Project Coordinators will work with locals to endorse a "Community Painting Day" to start several murals simultaneously and expedite the transplantation of these products within the community. Volunteers from the community will endure this Project

- Featured introduction and highlight during ribbon cutting ceremony.


Silver Level: \$1,000.00

- Featured alongside additional final donors on a specified mural.


